Students are required to take general education elective courses from at least two of the three categories in order to satisfy the breadth requirement which is part of the GBC policy. Please log into Degree Works to check to see that you are meeting this requirement.

General Education electives in the Spring/Summer 2024 semester will be delivered through synchronous, asynchronous, hybrid, or on campus sessions.

Synchronous online learning occurs at the same time. The teacher and students will meet online, on Blackboard Collaborate, and will interact with each other in real time. Students should plan to be available at the scheduled class times. Although classes are scheduled for three hours, the Collaborate sessions will likely take up only some of that time. Students will also need to do work independently.

Asynchronous learning <u>does not</u> occur in the same place or at the same time. Teachers and students do not need to be available at any particular time or day. Resources will be available on Blackboard, usually with instructions to complete weekly modules.

Hybrid learning combines asynchronous sessions and synchronous sessions. Teachers will provide more instructions for each course.
